The 18th annual Garma will take place from 29 July - 1 August, 2016, at the Gulkula ceremonial grounds in northeast Arnhem Land, 40 kilometers from the township of Gove in the Northern Territory.

We are looking for a small but dedicated team of volunteers to assist in a variety of roles, including event bump-in/bump-out, general maintenance of the campsite, program coordination & operational tasks such as transport coordination. Electricians and plumbers, in particular, are encouraged to apply.

Criminal history checks are essential and Working With Children cards will be integral if working with Garma Youth.

With more than 2000 guests on site over four action-packed days, this is a fantastic opportunity for those interested in gaining valuable hands-on experience in large-scale festival and event operations.
