Each year the Yothu Yindi Foundation presents their annual Garma Festival on a remote ceremonial meeting ground called Gulkula, 40kms from the township of Gove, Northern Territory.

Of the 2500 people that gather at Garma over four days worth of educational activities - 200 will participate in our Garma Youth Forum. This brings together a wide variety of schools and students from across Australia, from private schools to smaller remote Indigenous schools. The Garma Youth Forum is a fun camp to educate and inspire our youth, to build lifelong friendships and find opportunities for the future of our youths development.

Four days of programming will range from musical workshops, Yolngu cultural workshops, digital media, mobile journalism, physical activities, dance, and youth leadership development and fascinating fireside chats. Garma attracts a long list of interesting attendees, and the Yothu Yindi Foundation will enable opportunities for our youth to meet and interview VIP guests, musical artists and familiar Australian faces. Come and listen to inspirational talks from leaders as they share their life experiences and how they've overcome challenges to achieve and be the ultimate leaders within their communities today.

Up to 15 schools travel to NE Arnhem Land to explore astronomy, take part in health and nutrition workshops, receive careers guidance, and share a cup of tea with our Garma Ambassadors. Whether you're 8-18 years old, from the city or the bush, the Garma Youth Forum is THE PLACE TO BE come 29 July - 1 August 2016. The Garma Youth Forum provides a strong foundation for our next generation to find their confidence, strive for a bright future ahead and mingle with others who have the same outlook on life.
